The Chairman, Ministry Procurement Committee on behalf of the Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development, invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for “Procurement of 1775 Nos. Brand New Four-wheel Drive Automatic Transmission Diesel Double Cabs” for Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development, The Secretariat, Lotus road, Colombo 01.
2. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding procedure.
3. Qualification requirements to qualify for contract award include:
 - I. The bidder shall provide documentary evidence demonstrating experience in supplying and maintaining the offered make of Brand New Diesel Double Cabs during the last ten (10) years.
 - II. The bid shall be accepted only from an Authorized local agent nominated by the respective Manufacturer.
 - III. The bidder shall provide documentary evidence demonstrating experience in the supply of at least 1000 Nos. Brand New Diesel Double Cabs of the proposed make, within the last ten (10) years. This document shall be submitted with confirmation from the internal Auditor or External Auditor of the bidder’s Entity.
 - IV. The bidder shall maintain a minimum of ten (10) service and repair centers under the ownership of the respective bidder located island-wide, of which at least five (5) centers shall be situated outside the Western Province. A franchise or associate is not accepted.
 - V. The bidder shall have maintained a minimum average annual turnover of not less than Rs. 10,000 million (Rs. 10Bn) during the period 2017 to 2019, which is prior to the period of the vehicle importation ban (three consecutive years).
 - VI. The bidder shall submit documentary evidence confirming registration and compliance under the Public Contract Act, No. 03 of 1987 (PC3 Certificate).
 - VII. The bidder shall submit confirmation letters issued by the Department of Inland Revenue verifying tax compliance of the respective bidder.
 - VIII. Bidder shall submit a letter by confirming the proceeding the respective Letter of Credit facility through the bank nominated by the Procurement Entity.
 - IX. The bidder shall submit a Non-Collusion Affidavit.

6. 7. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after closing in the presence of the bidder/bidder’s representative who chooses to attend for bid opening.

No credit will be given to deliveries before the earliest date, and bids offering delivery after the final date shall be treated as non-responsive. Within this acceptable period, an adjustment, as specified in BDS Sub-Clause 35.3(d), will be added, for evaluation purposes only, to the bid price of bids offering deliveries later than the "Earliest Delivery Date" specified in Section VI ,

Option 2

The goods covered under this invitation are required to be delivered within an acceptable range of weeks specified in the Schedule of Requirement. No credit will be given to earlier deliveries, and bids offering delivery beyond this range will be treated as non-responsive. Within this acceptable range, an adjustment per week, as specified in the Bid Data Sheet, will be added for evaluation to the bid price of bids offering deliveries later than the earliest delivery period specified in the Schedule of Requirements

Option 3

The goods covered under this invitation are required to be delivered in partial shipments, as specified in the Schedule of Requirements. Bids offering deliveries earlier or later than the specified deliveries will be adjusted in the evaluation by adding to the bid price a factor equal to a percentage, specified in the Bid Data Sheet, of price per week of variation from the specified delivery schedule

(b) Deviation in payment schedule. [Insert one of the following]

Bidders shall state their bid price for the payment schedule outlined in the Contract Data. Bids shall be evaluated on the basis of this base price.
