The Week in Review
16 January – 19 January 2024

REAL SECTOR

- Economy contracted by 1.6 percent in third quarter 2023.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil declined by 0.12 USD bbl and WTI increased by 0.43 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) increased to 4.0 percent (YoY) in December, 2023 from 3.4 percent (YoY) in November, 2023
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) increased to 2.8 percent (YoY) in November, 2023 from 1.0 percent (YoY) in October, 2023

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee appreciated to USD 1=Rs.320.99 from USD 1=Rs. 322.58
- Exports increased to USD 1.00 bn in November 2023 compared to USD 0.93 bn in October 2023
- Imports declined to USD 1.39 bn in November 2023 compared to USD 1.61 bn in October 2023
- Trade deficit
 - USD 390 mn in November, 2023
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 3.6 bn as end of November

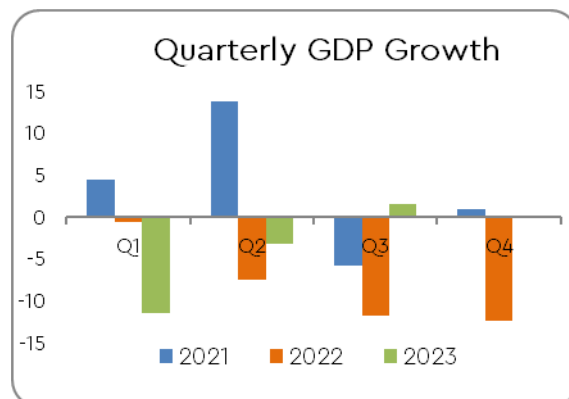

GDP grew by 1.6 % in the Q3 of 2023

In the third quarter of 2023, the economy grew by 1.6 percent compared to the 11.5 percent contraction in the same period of 2022. All the sectors of the economy, i.e. Agriculture, Industry and Services sectors expanded in the third quarter by 3.0 percent, 0.3 percent and 1.3 percent, respectively.

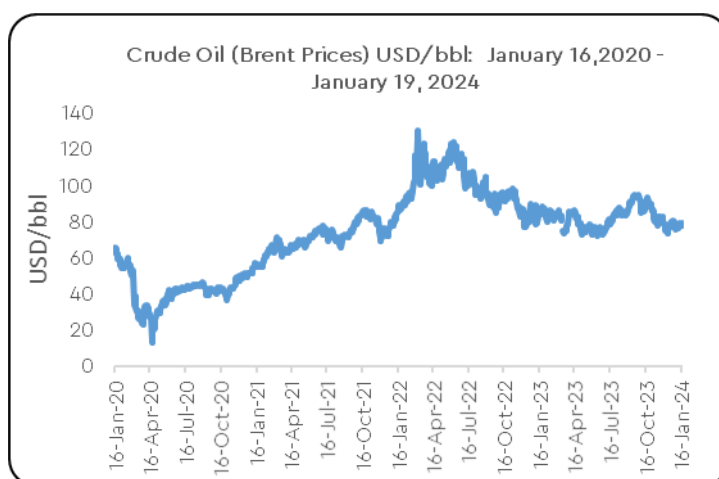

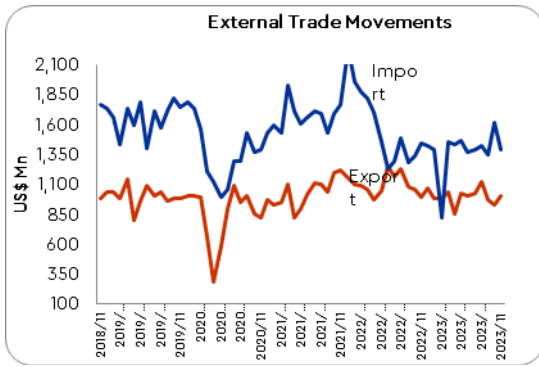

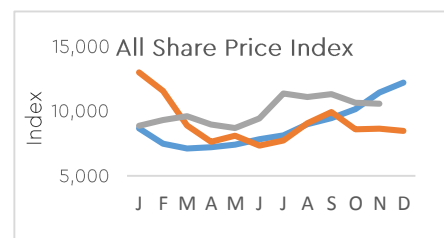
