REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.1 percent in the first quarter 2026.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil increased by 12.00 USD bbl and WTI increased by 10.77 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 8.0 percent (YoY) in August, 2026 from 7.3 percent (YoY) in July, 2026.
- NCPI – Headline inflation (2021=100) increased to 7.2 percent (YoY) in July, 2026 from 6.5 percent (YoY) in June 2026.

- The Sri Lankan rupee marginally depreciated to USD 1 = Rs. 328.56 from USD 1 = Rs. 328.40
- Exports increased to USD 1,233.4 mn in July 2026 compared to USD 1,143.8 mn in June 2026.
- Imports increased to USD 2,251.0 mn in July 2026 compared to USD 1,972.3 mn in June 2026.
- Trade deficit
 - USD 1,017.6 mn in July, 2026
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 6.9 bn as end of August 2026.
- Workers' remittances recorded USD 777.6 mn in July 2026.

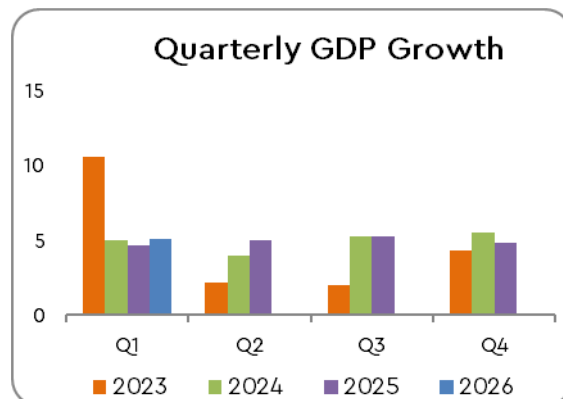

GDP expanded by 5.1 % in 1st quarter 2026

In the first quarter of 2026, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.1 percent compared to 4.7 percent growth recorded in the same period of 2025. This expansion was observed recording 1.1 percent, 7.2 percent and 3.4 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and service sector, respectively.

Highlights

- Export earnings increased by 7.8 percent to USD 1,233.4 mn in July 2026 compared to USD 1,143.8 mn in June 2026.
- Import expenditure increased by 14.1 percent to USD 2,251.0 mn in July 2026 compared to USD 1,972.3 mn in June 2026.
- Trade deficit widened to USD 1,017.6 mn in July 2026 compared to USD 828.5 mn in June 2026.

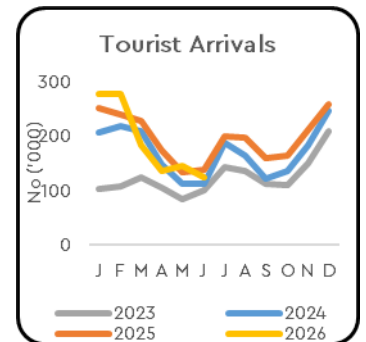

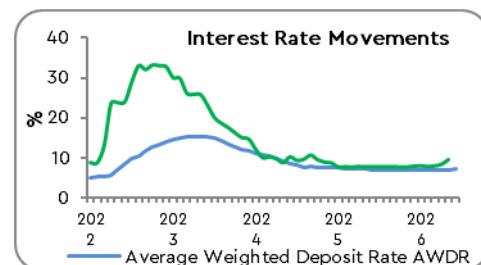

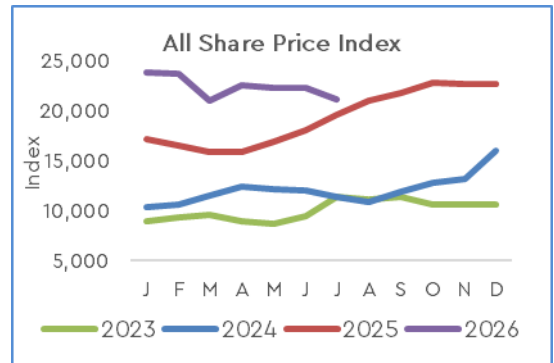
