The Week in Review  
29 July – 02 August 2024

### REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 5.3 percent in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2024.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil declined by 3.3 USD bbl and WTI declined by 2.8 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) increased to 2.4 percent (YoY) in July, 2024 from 1.7 percent (YoY) in June, 2024
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) increased to 2.4 percent (YoY) in June, 2024 from 1.6 percent (YoY) in May, 2024

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### EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly appreciated to USD 1=Rs. 303.33 from USD 1=Rs. 303.88
- Exports increased to USD 1.08 bn in June 2024 compared to USD 1.01 bn in May 2024
- Imports increased to USD 1.45 bn in June 2024 compared to USD 1.41 bn in May 2024
- Trade deficit
  - USD 369.6 mn in June, 2024
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 5.7 bn as end of June 2024.

### GDP expanded by 5.3 % in 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2024

In the first quarter of 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 5.3 percent, a notable improvement from the 10.7 percent contraction recorded in the same period of 2023. This expansion was observed across all economic sectors recording a 1.1 percent, 11.8 percent, and 2.6 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.

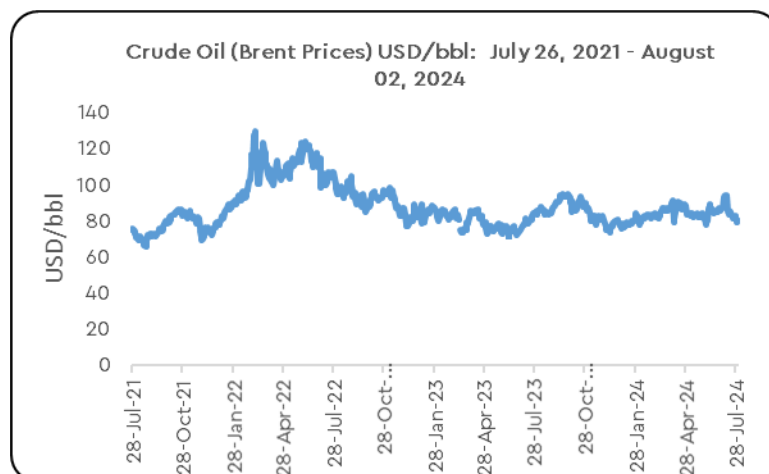

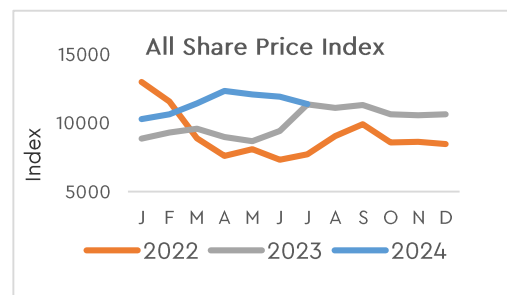
