The Week in Review
16 September – 20 September 2024

REAL SECTOR

- Economy expanded by 4.7 percent in the 2nd quarter 2024.
- Price of Brent Crude Oil declined by 0.58 USD bbl and WTI declined by 0.01 USD bbl, respectively.
- CCPI - Headline (2021=100) declined to 0.5 percent (YoY) in August, 2024 from 2.4 percent (YoY) in July, 2024
- NCPI - Headline (YoY%) (2021=100) declined to 1.1 percent (YoY) in August, 2024 from 2.5 percent (YoY) in July, 2024

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EXTERNAL SECTOR

- Sri Lankan rupee slightly appreciated to USD 1=Rs. 298.79 from USD 1=Rs. 299.98
- Exports increased to USD 1.13 bn in July 2024 compared to USD 1.08 bn in June 2024
- Imports increased to USD 1.73 bn in July 2024 compared to USD 1.45 bn in June 2024
- Trade deficit
 - USD 603.8 mn in July, 2024
- The gross official reserves stood at USD 5.7 bn as end of July 2024.

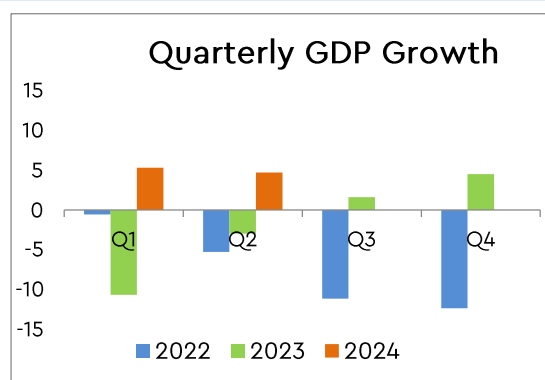

GDP expanded by 4.7 % in 2nd Quarter 2024

In the second quarter of 2024, the Sri Lankan economy experienced a growth of 4.7 percent, a notable improvement from the -3.0 percent contraction recorded in the same period of 2023. This expansion was observed across all economic sectors recording a 1.7 percent, 10.9 percent, and 2.5 percent growth in the agriculture, industry and services sectors, respectively.

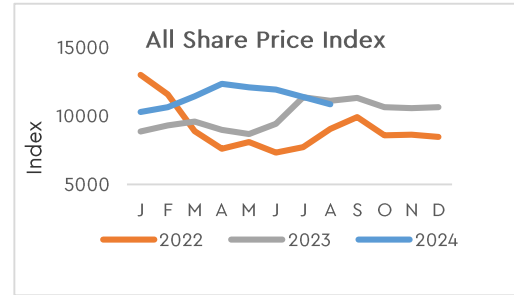
