### The Payment of Allowances - State Enterprises / Entities

### 1. Overview

The Government entities engage in regulatory, promotional, research, educational as well as other commercial activities. Accordingly, they are classified under different headings reflecting their involvements and responsibilities, in order to establish an effective supervisory and performance monitoring mechanism that will be facilitated by the Public Enterprises Department as well as to provide a rational basis to determine the amount of allowances to Chairman, Board Members, Working Directors etc.

### 1.1 Regulatory Agencies

Entities associated with regulatory function in terms of an Act of Parliament are deemed to be Regulatory Agencies. These Regulatory Agencies are further divided into Sub-category A and Sub-category B, based on their strategic importance.

### 1.2 Promotional Agencies

Entities associated with promotional activities are deemed to be Promotional Agencies. These Promotional Agencies which are divided into Sub-category A and Sub-category B, based on whether the entities are self-financed or otherwise.

### 1.3 Research and Development Agencies

Entities associated with research and development activities for the benefit of the public are deemed to be Research and Development Agencies.

### 1.4 Educational Agencies

Entities associated with tertiary and higher education, vocational and other training, as well as in the furtherance of knowledge of professionals are deemed to be Educational Agencies. These Educational Agencies are further divided into Sub-category A and Sub - category B, based on their task and responsibilities.

### 1.5 State Owned Enterprises

Entities engaged in commercial activities, that are incorporated by an Act of Parliament or under the Companies Act No. 7 of 2007, and in which the

Government owns the total or the majority shares are deemed to be State Owned Enterprises. These Agencies are further divided into Sub-categories A, B, C, D, E and F, according to their scale of operations, the share of Government investment in such entities, the asset base, the number of employees, associated business complexities and the contribution to the economy and the National Budget.

### 2. Payment of Allowances

The Monthly Allowance payable to Chairmen, Executive Directors and Working Directors and the Sitting Allowances payable to Board Members and Observers on a per-sitting basis for attending Board Meetings, Audit and Management Meetings, and any such meeting as may be required in terms of a statute or as may be required by a regulator, are given in Table 1.

2.1 A person, who holds the post of Chairman / Executive Director (ED) or Working Director (WD) in more than one entity, should avail allowances on the following basis, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Letter of Appointment or any previous decision given in that regard by the Management Services Department.

Full Allowance 50% of the Allowance 25% of the Allowance From the Second Office From the Third Office It should be noted that no person can claim remuneration/ an allowance, for serving in more than three Offices.

- 2.2 A person who acts as a Chairman, ED or WD is entitled for an acting allowance of 50% of the respective allowance for the period of such service provided such person has served in such post for a minimum of consecutive 28 days.
- 2.3 Any Chairman, Board Member, Executive Director, Working Director or a Observer who covers up duties of a permanent position in the same entity, cannot be paid any additional payment.
- 2.4 A reasonable Transport Allowance having taken into account the associated distance, be paid to a Board Member or an Observer for attending Board Meetings, audit and Management Meetings, or such other Meetings, provided such person has not been given a transport or a transport allowance by that institution.
- 2.5 This Circular will not apply to State Owned Enterprises in Sub-category F that are governed by the relevant Act of Incorporation, the Companies Act, the respective Articles of Association and provisions of other applicable laws including Taxes and other Regulatory provisions. The payment of allowances to Chairman, Board of Directors etc. as well as the salaries and other allowances and the terms and conditions of key executive officers of State Owned Enterprises in this Sub-category will therefore be decided by the respective Board of Directors having regard to competitive market rates paid by similar institutions, the educational and competence level of the person concerned, with the concurrence of the Hon. Minister of Finance and Planning.

### 3. Payment of Taxes

3.1 Monthly Allowances and Sitting Allowances to Chairman, Board of Directors, Executive Director (ED), Working Director (WD) or observers are liable to payment of tax, subject to applicable laws. Hence, it shall be the duty of all entities to ensure the deduction of 10 percent withholding tax and remitting the same to the Inland Revenue Department, where applicable and similarly it shall be the duty of all such persons to ensure the payment of such withholding tax from such payment.

### 4. Cancellation of Previous Circulars

Public Enterprises Circular No, PED 58 issued on 29th April 2011, PED 58 (1) issued on 27th June 2011 is hereby cancelled. Any clarification may be sought from the Public Enterprises Department of the Ministry of Finance and Planning.
